Morning ,

I have created a table based upon the planning applications provided (see below) which hopefully explains the rationale for why there was a request for one application but not the others.

All but one of the applications we have reviewed only affect Boundaries and Watercress, and whilst Boundaries is over capacity ,there is capacity at Watercress, and combined there is sufficient to accommodate the additional patients from each application. I have also looked at the approved applications and added in the additional patients from these (consented and commenced) and the result is still the same, there is sufficient combined capacity.

At present the total capacity for Boundaries and Watercress combined allows for an additional 1,072 patients and if we account for the 'consented and commenced' this drops to 837 patients.

For 58788/002 it was assessed that the patients could also register at Alresford Surgery (also over capacity) and the combined assessment for the three surgeries shows there is insufficient capacity for the application.

We understand that this approach ensures that the ICB requests are CIL compliant and where there is no capacity this supports the ICB contribution requests.

Very happy to discuss the ICB approach via Teams to see if there is a better or different way to assess.



This application has been reviewed from a primary care perspective and the response has been informed by the Health Contributions Approach which was jointly prepared with NHS England.

The GP surgeries within the catchment area that this application would affect, currently have sufficient infrastructure capacity to absorb the population increase that this potential development would generate.

However, due to the nature of the planning process, please be advised that this response from NHS Hampshire and Isle of Wight is a snapshot of the infrastructure capacity assessment at the date of this letter. Should there be any change to this position, as a result of any current planning applications that may or may not affect the capacity of Boundaries Surgery & The Watercress Medical Group being approved prior to a final decision on this particular development, then this will potentially initiate a further review of the NHS's position. Such factors could include but are not limited to:

- Increases in the patient list size which then exceed the GP surgeries capacity during the period between this application being validated and prior to a planning decision
- Consideration for future 'consented or commenced' planning applications that lead to an increase in the patient list size which then exceed the existing GP surgeries capacity during the period between this application being validated and prior to a planning decision.

Therefore, at this stage, it is important to highlight the NHS reserve the right to re-assess and respond to this application at any time, as a result of any planning application(s) received and approved subsequently by the Council that will have an associated impact on the assessed GP surgeries linked to this application, which in turn, could have the potential to initiate an NHS contribution request in accordance to regulatory and legislative obligations.

With this in mind, whilst at this time there is no requirement for a Section 106 contribution towards NHS Primary Care infrastructure from this application, as a contingency, we would recommend you take this into consideration, factoring in an estimated sum of £680 per dwelling towards NHS Primary Care infrastructure to any viability assessments.

Hope you're well. Could you help me with a query relating to Four Marks/Medstead please?

I note for a couple of applications you're not seeking S106 (ref: 27000/005 - Land to the rear and including Fair Winds, 61 Lymington Bottom Road, Medstead, Alton, GU34 5EP and 55318/001 Land East of Cawk House, Stoney Lane, Medstead, Alton).

However, for the one referenced above, you are. Note the date for the above is Oct 2023, and it hasn't yet been determined. Appreciate things keep moving on.

On the back of the two above that you aren't seeking contributions for, I said I would gather together some stats for you on FM/M (pending, approved, pre-app) so you can see what is on the horizon (it is what we expected, but sooner actually, in that the applications are rolling in..).

The case officer has sent me an email with these comments/questions:

Health -

I have attached comments from NHS, requesting a contribution. The attached letter is slightly confusing, because it notes capacity issues, but then states that CIL funding has been approved for works at Alton and recent works have been carried out at Alresford. I would have thought that these works will relieve capacity. For Four Marks, the attached letter suggest that they have put in a CIL bid to expand that medical centre, which could lead to double counting.

Whilst the applicant is not adverse to the principle of a healthcare contribution, they would like to ensure that it is CIL Reg 122 compliant. Currently there is an inconsistency in the responses received by the NHS consultation response (which is also supported by their response to app ref: 27000/005 and 55318/001 where they have not sought a contribution), one of which does not seek a contribution and the other does, because of the lack of capacity at the Alresford Surgery, in Winchester District. On the face of it, the availability of capacity in the surgeries in South Medstead and Four Marks, within close proximity to the site, seems to indicate a contribution would not be necessary – which would be consistent with the approach the NHS are taking to other sites in the settlement. However, Im not sure if this is a matter being secured through CIL.

Are you able to comment to help us understand? This site at Longbourn Way is right next to the Watercress surgery, which the ICB is currently seeking CIL for an extension (current bids, not yet decided). As far as we understand, the extension at Boundaries is fully funded with the CIL allocation, unless you say otherwise.

The applicant is reasonable, and if they get a recommendation to approve at committee, will probably not question the health contribution. I have spoken to the applicant and explained that health is a priority for the council. But it all has to be consistent, and compliant.
